#### THE LAW - Basic Safety training for Commercial Fishermen

ALL commercial fishermen are required to attend one day courses covering sea survival, firefighting, first aid, health & safety and safety awareness. Your vessels insurance is invalid if all onboard do not have the required certificates.

#### THE LAW – New Entrant Commercial Fishermen

Merchant Shipping Notice No 1813(F) states that all new entrants to the commercial fishing industry must attend a one-day basic sea survival course, BEFORE going to sea for the first time. If the candidate then remains in the industry, basic health & safety, first aid and firefighting courses must be attended within 3 months. Once basic safety training is complete, the safety awareness & accident prevention course must be attended within the first 2 years of service.

#### Free Training for New Entrants – Available Now!

Our free three day course is now available, 30 Oct-1 November, aimed at new entrants wishing to join the industry. This includes the sea survival certificate - free of charge, and also includes a range of other subjects giving the new entrant a good all-round knowledge before joining their first vessel.

We also have the Seafish 15 day course starting on 14<sup>th</sup> January. This is a more comprehensive course and includes all of the basic safety certificated courses required for all commercial fishermen. Please contact us for an application form.

#### Under 16.5m Skipper Ticket - Funding now available

This certificate is available to all experienced commercial fishermen who have attended the advanced courses in Bridge Watchkeeping, Engineering Watchkeeping, Stability Awareness and GMDSS Short Range Course. Applicants must have at least two years service in the fishing industry and must have completed basic safety training as mentioned above.

#### GMDSS Short Range Radio – Free of charge

This course is also required in order to qualify for the Skipper Ticket For the Unrestricted (Gold) skipper cert, the 5 day bridge/engine courses are required, and for the Restricted (Silver) skipper cert, the 2 day bridge/engine courses are required. Full details are contained in MGN 411 (M+F)

## Safety Training Courses

### Sea Survival, Portland, Eastbourne, Poole, dates overleaf

Starting at 9am at the Osprey Leisure Centre, Castletown, Portland, Eastbourne Fishermens Club, and the PHC Training Suite, Poole Port (map supplied on booking), completing by 4.30pm. The course consists of lectures, films and demonstrations on safety procedures and survival equipment, with a "wet drill" in the swimming pool in the afternoon. A clean change of clothing is required for the wet drill. All other equipment is supplied. **Cost, £145, payable on booking.**

### New Entrant Health & Safety, Bristol, Lyme Regis & Shoreham, dates over

Starting at 9am at Building 7, Underfall Yard, Cumberland Road, Bristol, BS1 6XG, the Cobb Centre, Lyme Regis and the Shoreham Lifeboat Station, Brighton Road, Shoreham by Sea (map supplied on booking), completing by 4pm. **This course is mandatory for all new entrants** and covers basic health & safety issues and safety practices in a dangerous work environment. Topics also include safety equipment/clothing and accident prevention. **Cost: £110, payable on booking.**

### First Aid(STCW95), Bristol, Lyme Regis Poole Brixham, Shoreham

Starting at 9am, at Building 7, Underfall Yard, Cumberland Road, Bristol, BS1 6XG, the Fishermens College, The Cobb, Lyme Regis, PHC Training Suite, Unit 4, Poole Port and the Training Rooms, Brixham Port Authority (map supplied on booking), completing around 4pm. The day consists of lectures, films and practical demonstrations on all the latest first aid techniques, together with practical sessions on CPR and bandaging etc. The course also includes a module on Category C medical stores, IAW MGN147. **Cost - £110, payable on booking.**

### Basic Firefighting, Bristol, Lyme Regis, Eastbourne & Poole, dates overleaf

Starting at 9am at the Building 7, Underfall Yard, Cumberland Road, Bristol, BS1 6XG, Cobb Centre, Lyme Regis, Poole Harbour Commissioners training suite and the Eastbourne Fishermens Club (map supplied on booking). The morning consists of lectures and films on fire prevention and firefighting techniques, followed by a fire drill in the afternoon, where each candidate will gain valuable experience using the various extinguishers on real fires. Wet weather gear may be required, and old clothing is advised due to smoke etc. Safety boots/protective footwear recommended. **Cost - £125 payable on booking.**

### Safety Awareness, Lyme Regis, Weymouth & Eastbourne, see overleaf

Starting at 9am at the Fishermens College, Lyme Regis, Safewise Centre, Radipole Lane, Weymouth and Eastbourne Fishermens Club (map supplied on booking) completing by 4pm. **This course is mandatory for all experienced fishermen**, and covers aspects of how accidents happen, with guidelines on how to prevent them and how to minimise damage and injury when they do happen. Guidance on risk assessment is also included, which may help with insurance applications and claims. A risk assessment manual is issued free of charge on the day. (subject to availability) **Cost, £110, payable on booking.**

## Courses leading to the issue of the Under 16.5m Skipper Certificate Courses can be organised at most ports for anyone wishing to obtain these certificates

### GMDSS SRC , Lyme Regis and Poole, dates over

Starting at 9am each day at the fishermens college on the Cobb, Lyme Regis, DT7 3JJ and the Poole Harbour Commissioners Training Suite, Unit 4, Poole Port (map supplied on booking). The first day consists of lectures and demonstrations on general theory and voice procedures for using VHF radio, with practical sessions on voice procedures and use of GMDSS DSC radios in the afternoon. Second day consists of practical sessions followed by the exam, completing lunchtime. **Cost - free of charge for eligible fishermen or £125 payable on booking, with a separate exam fee of £60 payable to the RYA examiner on the day. A Passport photograph is also required for the exam.**

### Intermediate and Advanced Stability Awareness, dates overleaf

Starting at 9am completing by 4pm at the fishermens college the Cobb, Lyme Regis (map supplied on booking) Due to continuing accidents involving stability of fishing vessels, this course has been introduced free of charge for all eligible commercial fishermen. The course covers aspects of how stability problems happen, with practical demonstrations using a scale model fishing vessel. **Cost: free of charge for eligible fishermen or £110 payable on booking.**

### Bridge Watchkeeping, 2 or 5 day, dates overleaf

Starting at 9am, completing by 4pm each day at the Fishermens College, Lyme Regis, the Fishermens Club, Eastbourne and the PHC training Suite, Poole. The course covers aspects of navigation, collision avoidance regulations, and many other useful tips on bridge watchkeeping. The two day course is aimed at fishermen operating up to 20 miles, and the 5 day course is more advanced, for those wishing to operate beyond 20 miles. **Cost: free of charge for eligible fishermen.**

### Marine Engineering, Lyme Regis, dates overleaf

Starting at 9am each day at the Fishermens College, Lyme Regis. The 4 day course qualifies for the issue of the MCA 30 hour certificate, and the 2 day course qualifies for the Seafish Engineer Watchkeeping certificate. Full information supplied on request. **Costs - free of charge for eligible fishermen.**
